## Report of Cruise 67-8, Shrimp

Vessel:

MV Sunrise

Dates:

August 28-30, 1967

Objectives:

1. To compare catch rates of day and night shrimp tows.

2. To compare size, sex ratio, and age composition of shrimp caught during day and night towing.

Methods:

The shrimp trawl was a 41-foot headrope Gulf semi-balloon trawl. The catch was sorted after each tow. Fish were either counted or weighed or both by species as time permitted. A one-half to one pound random shrimp sample was weighed, measured, and sexed.

Results:

Day towing produced higher catch rates than night towing. Table 1 shows the results of the 9 day and 6 night tows. The shrimp per pound caught during the day averaged 141 and ranged from 129 to 158. Night tows ranged in count from 120 to 136 shrimp per pound, averaging 129. The per cent of males caught during the day averaged 60% and ranged from 53% to 67%. Night tows had from 39% to 54% males averaging 47%. Forty-five per cent of the night-caught shrimp and 58% of the day-caught shrimp were one-year old males. A length-frequency distribution by sex of day and night caught shrimp is shown in Figure 1.


