FISH COMMISSION OF OREGON GROUNDFISH & SHRIMP INVESTIGATIONS

Report of Cruise 70-13, Deepwater Dover Sole

- Vessel: M/V Columbia, commercial trawler.
- Dates: December 26-27, 1970
- Objective: To tag Dover sole in PMFC area 2B for migration studies.
- Methods: Gear used was a Norwegian trawl of 5-inch mesh. General area fished was from just north of Reedsport to just south of Heceta Head in 175 to 320 fathoms. Dover sole were collected from the commercial catch and tagged with Petersen disc tags. Duration of tows averaged three hours. Fish were measured to the nearest centimeter.
- Results: There were 276 fish tagged from the catches of four tows. Tagging information is listed in Table 1.
