Report of Cruise 71-3, Dover sole

Vessel: M/V Harmony, commercial trawler.

Dates: August 3-5, 1971

Objectives: 1. To tag Dover sole in PMFC area 2B for migration studies.

- 2. To collect scales from fish tagged for aging studies. Gear used was a 400-mesh trawl of 5-inch mesh. The general
- Methods: Gear used was a 400-mesh trawl of 5-inch mesh. The general area fished was from just north of Cape Blanco to Coos Bay in 60 to 134-fathoms of water. Dover sole were collected from the commercial catch and tagged with peterson disc tags. Fish were measured to the nearest centimeter. Scales were taken at tagging and placed in numbered coin envelopes.
- Results: There were 468 fish tagged from 8 tows. Tagging information is shown in Table 1.
