Remarks: After a calm night we put the gear in the water about 6 miles west of Leng Beach, washington. Word of the good fishing must have reached the fleet since a large number of boats began consentrating in this one area. However, the fish had "slacked off" and a good indication that this was true was the general scattering and disappearing of the boats as the day were on. One of the spoons were using, an Andy Beaker, Gold and Bronse Ho. 7, had, during these two trips, been easily outfishing any of the others. However, during this particular day it had an astounding amount of success. The finh birds began to scatter looking for finh feed. Very few undersize fish appears in the catch. If these small fish are not detected on the line within 15 to 30 minutes, depending on where they are booked, the air bladder fills up with water, killing the fish. Around 3 PM beats were seen pulling up their poles and heading for the river due to the lack of fish. 62 fish, all chinooks, were tagged.

The sea was chopping up more than any of the previous days and a heavy mist was falling. Later these conditions cleared up. Stomachs were empty as on the 9th. When this condition persists it will be noticed that fishing is also poor and the reverse seems to be true when fish are feeding heavily. Picking was fairly good but most of the boats in the area headed for Astoria early in the afternoon probably due to predictions of mederate southerly winds for the evening. At 4:30 p.m. we too picked up the goar in time to catch the last of the flood tide home. Sh fish, all chinook, were tagged in the course of the day.
