Remarks: Started fishing at 6:30 a.m. and tagged 40 fish, one of them a silver, before 10 a.m. The news from Westport, Wn. sounded good and we could see many boats passing us, with poles up, running that direction.

Finally, at 10 a.m. we could stand the strain no longer so we picked up the gear and left very good fishing to run north after the fleet.

Two hours later the gear was thrown out and trolling commenced in a northerly direction. About 3 p.m. we trolled into the fleet of some 70 boats off Westport. The trip north had been our undoing since only two fish were caught and tagged.

At 8 p.m. the gear came up and the hook went out.

Total for the day - 41 chinook and 1 silver.

We caught only a few fish the first six hours but at 5:00 p.m. they began hitting in unusually large numbers. I was forced to quit taking scales in order to tag all fish which were caught. The fishing was as good as I've ever seen it. This continued until about 8:45 when darkness began to close in. There were only about 6 other boats enjoying this good fishing in the area. In all, 91 fish were tagged.

Remarks: After a calm night we put the gear in the water about 6 miles west of Long Beach, Washington. Word of the good fishing must have reached the fleet since a large number of boats began concentrating in this one area. However, the fish had "slacked off" and a good indication that this was true was the general scattering and disappearing of the boats as the day wore on. One of the spoons we were using, an Andy Becker, Gold and Bronze No. 7, had, during these two trips, been easily outfishing any of the others. However, during this particular day it had an astounding amount of success. The fish birds began to scatter looking for fish feed. Very few undersize fish appeared in the catch. If these small fish are not detected on the line within 15 to 30 minutes, depending on where they are hooked, the air bladder fills up with water, killing the fish. Around 3 PM boats were seen pulling up their poles and heading for the river due to the lack of fish. 62 fish, all chinooks, were tagged.

Remarks: After spending our third night anchored off the Washington coast we threw out the fishing gear at 6:00 a.m. for what proved to be the fourth and last day of fishing on this particular trip. The sea was chopping up more than any of the previous days and a heavy mist was falling. Later these conditions cleared up. Stomachs were empty as on the 9th. When this condition persists it will be noticed that fishing is also poor and the reverse seems to be true when fish are feeding heavily. Fishing was fairly good but most of the boats in the area headed for Astoria early in the afternoon probably due to predictions of moderate southerly winds for the evening. At 4:30 p.m. we too picked up the gear in time to catch the last of the flood tide home. 54 fish, all chinook, were tagged in the course of the day.
