Project Summary

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2011 Kids Fish Camp at Camp Angelos

Activity Type: Education

Summary: The Camp Angelos Youth Fishing Camp is a one week resident summer

camp for 80 boys and girls ages 9-14. The camp includes daily meals, lodging, all equipment and professional instruction by voulnteers from ODFW Angler Ed., NW Steelheaders, Oregon Bass and Panfish Club and

other local fishing groups. Campers will experience a variety of fishing related activities and projects throughout the 5 day camp.

Objectives: The objectives of this camp are to offer youth and disadvantaged youth the

opportunity to learn about different types of angling, fishing equipment, safety, the ecology of streams and ponds, as well as fish conservation challenges. Goals of the Fish Camp aare: 1) Each camper will learn how to fish for trout and warm water fish 2) Know how to clean a fish and prepare it for cooking. 3)In order to promote fishing after the camp each angler will receive a spinning rod, reel, and tackle to take home with the challenge to "take an adult fishing." 4) All campers will have the

opportunity to fish daily in the camp trout pond with a special trip hosted by the Oregon Bass and Panfish Club to Blue Lake to fish for warm water fish.

5) Each angler will be given information where to fish in the greater portland area. (50 Places to go fishing within 60 minutes of Portland)

Fishery Benefits: More young anglers now will lead to additional adult anglers and an

enhanced recreational fishery in the future. This projects directly supports

the ODFW 25 Year Angling Enhancement Plan.

Current Situation: Camp Angelos is a non profit camp used by the Multnomah Educational

Service District Outdoor School Program, Camp Agape, a camp for kids with cancer and their families, and many church groups for week long

camps for kids.

Designer: Oregon Wildlife Heritage Foundation and ODFW Angler Ed Program

Methods: Using volunteer instructors we will provide instruction to the young anglers

about rigging for trout, spin and fly casting, still water fishing, and about the "catch and release" philosophy and/or requirement. Camp participants will also learn about cleaning and preparing fish for cooking, fly tying, trout life

cycle, and riparian habitats.

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
