Project Summary

This project is part of ODFW's 25 Year Angling Plan.

Activity Type: Education

Summary: The 2013 Fish Camp is a one week resident summer camp for 80 to 100

boys and girls ages 9-14. The camp includes daily meals, lodging, all equipment and professional instruction by volunteers from ODFW, NW Steelheaders, Oregon Bass and Panfish Club, NW Flyfishers, and other local fishing groups. Campers will experience a variety of fishing related

activites and projects throughout the 5 day camp.

Objectives: The objectives of this camp are to offer youth and disadvantaged youth the

opportunity to learn about different types of angling, fishing equipment,

water safety, the ecology of streams and ponds, as well as fish conservation challenges. Goals of Fish Camp are:

1)Each camper will know how to fish for trout and warm water fish 2)Know how to clean, prepare, and cook the fish they catch 3)All campers the opportunity to fish daily in the camp pond with a special trip hosted by the Oregon Bass and Panfish Club fishing for warm water fish. Each angler will be given information where to fish in the greater Portland area (50 Places to go fishing within 60 minutes of Portland) 5) In order to promote fishing after the camp each angler will receive a spinning rod, reel, and tackle to take home with the challenge to "take an adult fishing"

Fishery Benefits: More young anglers now will lead to additional adult anglers and an

enhanced recreational fishery in the future. This project directly supports

the ODFW 25 Year Angling Enhancement Plan.

Watershed Benefits: These young anglers will gain an understanding of the benefits of clean

and unpolluted streams to fish and wildlife.

Current Situation: Camp Angelos is a non profit camp used by the Multnomah Educational

Service District Outdoor School Program, Camp Agape, a camp for kids with cancer and their familes, Shriner's Hospital, Big Brother/Big Sister Program, and many church groups for week long summer camps for kids. All of these groups are welcome to fish in the camp pond and have access

to the camp fishing tackle.

Methods: Using volunteer instructors we will provide instruction to young anglers

about rigging for trout and warm water fish, spin and fly casting, still water fishing, and about the "catch and release" philosophy and/or requirement. Camp participants will also learn about cleaning and cooking fish, fly tying,

trout life cycle, and riparian habitat.


