Project Summary

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Activity Type: Miscellaneous (Enhancement)

Summary: Grant funds will be used to purchase a windmill driven aerator for Pagoda

Pond at the 4H Center.

Objectives: The windmill will provide extra oxygen and circulation to help maintain

water quality in Pagoda Pond during the late summer and early fall months.

Fishery Benefits: With assistance from ODFW, the Senior Fishing Buddies, and Northwest

This project is NOT part of ODFW's 25 Year Angling Plan.

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Watershed Benefits:

During the late summer and early fall, the water quality in Pagoda Pond is limited by a lack of fresh water input and warm temperatures. An aerator will help add Oxygen to the water and circulate cooler water up to the pond surface.

Current Situation:

Pagoda Pond is spring fed, about one surface acre, and about 10 to 15 feet deep. It has some aquatic vegetation, but staff clears excess plants a couple times a year to keep fishing areas open. There are three fishing platform/dock structures plus a fishing area on a small island and a trail around the entire pond. There is no electricity to the pond.

Legal size trout have been stocked in the pond through the Youth Angling Enhancement Program. STEP fry from local schools are released in Pagoda Pond each spring and some of these fish have survived to catchable size. In the late summer and early fall when fresh water intake into the pond is limited, the water quality in the pond becomes less than ideal for trout. Although some fish do survive, conditions are stressful for the fish


