Project Summary

This project is NOT part of ODFW's 25 Year Angling Plan.

Activity Type: Hatchery Maintenance - ODFW
Summary: These funds would be used to help replace Big Creek Hatchery's out dated and broken down tractor with a new tractor. A little more than half of the cost of the tractor will be covered using ODFW funds, mainly Mitchell Act funds.
Objectives: Our objective is to acquire a new tractor that meets this facilities specific need.
Fishery Benefits: Big Creek hatchery produces 6.4 million Fall Chinook, and 1.4 million Coho that contribute to NE Pacific and Columbia River Basin commercial and sport fisheries. Big Creek Hatchery also produces 143,000 Winter Steelhead for freshwater harvest in Big Creek, Gnat Creek, and the Klaskanine River. The new tractor is needed for keeping sport fishing access trails open below the hatchery, maintaining the sport fishermen's

parking lot, removing large debris at our intake, repairs and upkeep of our facility and intake roads, cleaning out our pollution abatement pond, and spawning operations.

Watershed Benefits:

Current Situation: The tractor we currently have is nearly 50 years old and inoperable due to repairs needed on the transmission, clutch, starter, hydraulics, and wiring. The repairs would be too costly.

Alternatives: Repairs to existing tractor were considered, but when considering the cost of the repairs given the age of the tractor, this did not seem like a good use of funds.

Designer: Tractor dealer

Methods: Will go out to ORPIN for bids.

Inspector: Rob Dietrichs

Funding Elements: Half the cost of purchasing a new tractor.

ODFW has agreed to contribute \$21,500 towards the cost of the tractor, most of which will come from funds provided by the Mitchell Act.

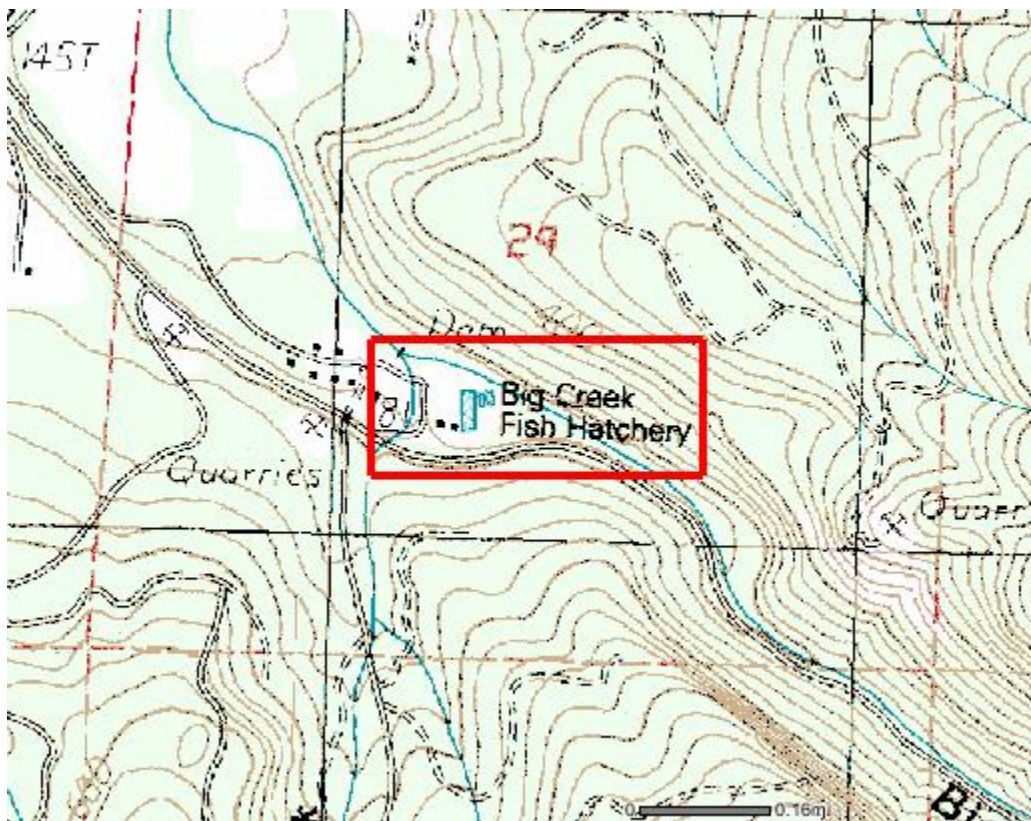
